Richard A. Baltisberger, M.D., FAAP, is chief of Pediatrics at Licking Memorial Hospital. He received his Medical Degree from University of North Dakota School of Medicine in Grand Forks, North Dakota. He completed a pediatric internship and residency at Nationwide Children's Hospital in Columbus, Ohio. Dr. Baltisberger is board certified in pediatrics.



Known as "Dr. Rick" by his young patients, he has dedicated much of his professional career helping children with physical and medical challenges. He serves as the camp physician for LMHS' Camp Feelin' Fine, a day-long program for children with asthma. He is a member of the National Advisory Committee for Down syndrome, which sets standards and promotes research in Down syndrome issues. He also provides physician services to the Kids' Place, a Newark facility that care for young victims of child abuse.

His honors include: 40 Under 40 by Columbus Business First; Hometown Hero from the Red Cross and 2010 Physician of the Year for LMH.

He lives in Granville with his wife, Jane, and four children.
