Program:

Dr. Harold Kelch introduced our speaker, Dr. Nick Reed, aka, Dr. Icky Nicky. Dr. Reed practiced medicine for 35 years, having performed over 12,000 deliveries and 10,000 surgeries in Newark. He is a former long-time member of the Newark Rotary Club. Dr. Reed is also a clown, having completed training in 2008.

In complete clown costume, "Dr. Icky Nicky" shared that he pursued becoming a clown in part because he has always been a "child at heart." Dr. Reed shared the complex and extensive organization of clowns, COA, and told us he has placed in many national competitions. He continues to compete in national clown competitions and attend national clown conferences.

Dr. Reed currently teaches clown classes especially in the areas of clowns involved with hospitals and nursing homes. He stated that medicine has become high-tech and the therapeutic clowns in hospitals and nursing homes help patients deal with the emotional and spiritual needs. "A Clown's humor comes from the heart and reminds of us joy and hope." Dr. Reed went on to say that hospitals can be scary places and laughter contributes to a healthy body and mind.

Dr. Reed currently resides in Lake Placid, Fla., which by the way, "has the highest number of clowns in the U.S per capita except Washington DC".
