Lisa was born and raised in Columbus and has spent the last 20 years providing service to our state. She received her bachelor's degree from Bowling Green State University in education and political science. She received a law degree from the University of Michigan and a masters in educational policy and leadership from The Ohio State University. She worked for the Ohio Attorney General

drafting Lemon Law Legislation and the United Nations assisting the Security Council on Disarmament. Lisa has also been a strong influence on educational policy in Ohio as the Ohio Legislative Director for Career Technical Education in Washington D.C. During this time Lisa was able to testify on Capitol Hill and secure funding for the Perkins Reauthorization bill which provided crucial funding to the Ohio Department of Education. Lisa has also taught a range of students from elementary through post secondary education and most recently from The Metro STEM School in Columbus. Lisa joined The Works this past June as the new STEM Education Coordinator.
