Past President **Tom Slater**, accompanied by Don Past President **Tom Slater** initiated the meeting with R-O-T-A-R-Y and then President **Jeff Lawyer** called the meeting to order. **Dick Reed** offered the invocation, a moment of silence for those in the armed forces in honor of Pearl Harbor Day. **Tom Slater** returned to the podium to lead us in Rudolph the Red Nosed Reindeer.

President Elect **Gary Baker** introduced two Rotarians: Joel Spahr from the Newark-Heath Club and Amy Huddleson from Granville.

President **Jeff Lawyer** announced the Special Needs Bowling will take place on December 15<sup>th</sup>. Please contact **Jack Neely** to volunteer. He thanked the members who served as Salvation Army Bell Ringers. We raised over \$800.

The Board was set to meet on December 9<sup>th</sup> in the Norman R. and Alethia E. Sleight Community Room on the Newark campus.

Past President **Nelson McCray** announced the slate of officers and reminded the club that we will vote on December 14<sup>th</sup>. **Jack Neely** and **Chuck Moore** are running.

Sergeant of Arms **Pat Jeffries** fined **Judge Higgins** for his recent award presented by the Mental Health Board; **Jerry Nethers** for the article about Freedom Years; **Donna Carpenter** for the Trend Magazine article, A Day in the Life; **Rob Montagnese, Chris Meyer, and Hal Kelch** for being photographed at the dedication of the new Salvation Army shelter; **Cara Riddel** for participating in the Elvis Run. Pat then auctioned off OSU Basketball tickets; congratulations to **Jim Matesich**.

#### Program:

Board Member **Laura Lewis** introduced President Elect **Gary Baker**.

Gary provided a Blue Ribbon Project Update. He provided an overview of the types of projects Rotarians are engaging in worldwide including: the Trimble School District project where an Indian club raised funds for an Ohio Appalachian school district, and the Cross Fell Challenge raising funds for shelter boxes, and the Plymouth-Dakar Rally which was a road race.

He detailed the projects our club has engaged in since December 2006 including the Koulouniko Water Project (\$25,000), the Rafiki Aids Orphanage expansion of the farm land (\$20,000), and the creation of the Newark Ohio Rotary Club Technical School (\$20,000).

Gary talked about how Rotary International has a presence all over the world including Pakistan, Afghanistan and Moscow. Rotarians are able to accomplish extraordinary projects like the Rotary Book Drive which broke the Guinness World Record.

Gary then spoke of the partnership with Montana De Luz, The Mountain of Light. Gary expressed the challenges the committee has faced in trying to

purchase the 35 passenger van and the difficulty in securing matching dollars due to the change in vision internationally. He was thrilled to announce that we have come up with a plan; we are purchasing a 15 passenger van. This project would not have been completed without the support of four Paul Harris Fellows: Jack Crockford, Tony Adams, Dave Froelich, Jim Murray and the entire club who donated a total of \$21,000.

Several other clubs supported the initiative: Granville \$5,000, Cambridge \$1,000, Mt Vernon \$500. The total amount raised was \$31,500 and we were able to secure \$8,500 from district 6690 resulting in a final total of \$40,000.

The group has also decided to offer the balance of the funds, \$10,000, to help repair the road. We should all be proud of the \$75,000 raised to support Blue Ribbon Projects over the past four years. Gary was given a standing ovation to recognize his dedication, hard work on this committee.

A formal check presentation was made to Erika, the new Executive Director of Montana De Luz. She shared a few comments about the extraordinary work that is being done at their facility. She addressed the challenges they are facing as the children are



living longer and preparing for continuing education. This next year they will have four children ready for college. She referenced several upcoming fundraisers and service trips. You can go to [www.montanadeluz.org](http://www.montanadeluz.org) for more information.
