## This week's Meeting: Jeff Danby

Michael Carey is the President of the American Council for Affordable and Reliable Energy (ACARE), a Washington, DC based public policy organization that advocates a balanced approach on energy issues in order to protect and enhance our nation's economic and national security. The organization believes that these public policies should not arbitrarily or unfairly discriminate among energy sources and should be based on sound science and cost-effective and growth-promoting government regulation.

Mr. Carey is a much sought after voice on the national level on energy and climate change issues. He has testified before both houses of Congress, frequently speaks to political groups including the Tea Party, and regularly appears on talk radio, the Fox News Channel, and other media outlets. Mr. Carey has frequently criticized the Obama Administration's EPA restrictions on energy as a "war on coal" that will limit the prosperity and opportunity of average Americans.

Since 1999, Mr. Carey has served as the President of the Ohio Coal Association. As the state's chief advocate for Ohio's coal industry, he is responsible for representing its interests before Ohio's General Assembly. Mr. Carey directs the association's legislative agenda and develops media contacts in order to strengthen the voice of Ohio's coal industry. Mr. Carey also oversees the association's financial matters, including its Political Action Committee and fundraising events. Mr. Carey currently chairs the Ohio Coal Development Office Technical Advisory Committee, and is a member of the Ohio Energy Task Force, the National Coal Council, National Mining Association, the Society for Mining, Metallurgy and Exploration, and the Ohio Chamber of Commerce.

Prior to joining the Ohio Coal Association, Mr. Carey served both as a staff member and as a volunteer for several state and federal officials. Mr. Carey held several staff positions in Congressional offices, where he acted as a liaison between the office and other government agencies and was responsible for management of the district staff.

From 1989-1999 Mr. Carey served the United States as an officer with the United States Army Reserves. His education includes a Bachelor of Arts in History from The Ohio State University and Associate of Science Degree in Economics from the Marion Military Institute.

Mr. Carey also served on the Capitol Square Foundation Board, Foundation for Appalachia Ohio, United Conservatives of Ohio and the Ohio Commodores. Mr. Carey resides in Granville, Ohio with his wife Kristin and their son Prescott.

**Bob McGaughy** then introduced our speaker, Jeff Danby who is the author of a book that he referenced for his presentation, titled "Day of the Panzer." Jeff started researching "how his grandfather died" during World War II in August 2000. This World War II story is the documentation of the incidents surrounding the southern invasion of France on Aug. 26, 1944, where Jeff's grandfather, Edgar Danby was killed when his tank unit was shelled by the Germans. This was one of the bloodiest battles between German and U. S. troops as well as French forces. Jeff was able to interview numerous soldiers and French residents who shared their memories and stories about these infamous days in World War II where 2,000 soldiers were killed and hundreds died in the "Champaign Campaign". It was a very interesting presentation.
