Last Week's Meeting

Tom Slater opened the meeting with song, R-O-T-A-R-Y. President **Nelson McCray** welcomed the club. **Jerry Jackson** led the invocation and the pledge. **Tom Slater** led the club as we celebrated the June birthdays. We also sang "End of the Year" in honor of the installation of the new officers. President-elect **Jeff Lawyer** introduced the guests: Damon Kuhn from the Logan Club, Tom Lawyer, guest of **Phil Shannon**, Rita Adams, guest of **Tony Adams** and **Kathy Lawyer**, guest of **Jeff Lawyer**.

President **Nelson McCray** thanked the club members who have participated in committee work over the past year and acknowledged the

support he has received while serving as president. He introduced **Bob McGaughy**, former club president, who presided over the Installation of Officers.

Program:

Bob McGaughy began by sharing that we had gathered to install our 95th president, Jeff Lawyer. He shared the story of our first Newark Rotary Club president, J. Howard Jones, an attorney who assumed the role in 1916. Between J. Howard Jones and Jeff Lawyer, 90 men and 3 women have served our club as president. As of today, 56 of our past presidents are deceased, 8 have relocated or are inactive and 29 remain active. Bob detailed the history of the first club meeting which was held on May 9, 1916, at Kuster's Restaurant in the Arcade Annex in downtown Newark. Those in attendance included: an attorney, a banker, a chemist, a clothier, a doctor, a grave marker, a hardware merchant, an insurance agent, a lumber merchant, a minister, a newspaper published and a school superintendent. Our club is the third oldest in our district and the 2nd largest. We have seen at least 9 international presents visit our club. He shared we have only met at 9 different locations since the first meeting in 1916. Bob talked about making a Rotary Resolution. By working toward a Rotary New Year resolution, we would all become better Rotarians and would strengthen our club and assure a brighter future for Rotary! He challenged each member to take on a new priority/task by focusing on attendance, committee work, blue ribbon projects, etc. Together we make the club a better place.

After sharing a wonderful historical review, he began the ceremony that began as a part of the 90th anniversary year celebrations when Cindy Steen was installed as the President in 2006. Bob introduced each of the past presidents as they came forward to receive the presidential gavel and exchange it with a successor, symbolizing the passing of leadership from one president to the other.
