Program:

Today's Program: Emergency speaker **Michele Layman** put aside her Rotogram notebook and stepped up to the plate and did an excellent presentation at the last minute on Polio Plus. This is the No. 1 program for Rotary nationwide. It is caused by a virus and usually affects children under the age of 5. There is no cure; we can only prevent it. It became an epidemic in the U.S. in 1916 and the first vaccine wasn't administered until 1954. The last case of polio in the U.S. was in 1991. In 1994, the western hemisphere was polio free. Today, there are still four countries who suffer from this virus: Northern India; Northern Nigeria; Pakistan and Afghanistan. We need to keep immunizing.

At the end of her presentation, **President Lawyer** presented Mrs. Layman with a Rotary pen, to add to her collection of Rotary items.
