## This week's program: Retired Judge Jon Spahr

A Miami University alumnus, Spahr studied law at the Ohio State University with Ohio Supreme Court Chief Justice Thomas Moyer. After graduation, Spahr practiced law for 15 years as a partner at McDonald, Robinson, Spahr and Noecker in Newark. Licking County Municipal Court Judge Michael Higgins, who has known Spahr personally and professionally for many years, said Spahr was an excellent defense attorney that prosecutors always enjoyed facing in court -- even if it meant a tougher fight. Spahr was appointed to the bench at the Licking County Municipal Court in 1979, where he spent four years before he was selected to replace Judge Winston Allen in common pleas court. In 1996, Spahr and four other faculty members of the National Judicial College traveled to Kazakhstan and Kyrgyzstan to teach other judges about the U.S. judicial system. Spahr served as the chair of the Ohio Judicial Conference, president of the Ohio Common Pleas Judges' Association and an instructor at both the Ohio and National Judicial College.

Score started in 1964 as the Service Corps of Retired Executives and was made up of Retired Business Executives willing to counsel individuals wanting to set up a small business. It has grown and now includes professionals still employed but willing to donate time. In 1997, they started cyber counseling and in 2009 93,000 counseling sessions were done on line. Members of our club volunteering with SCORE include Glen Abel, Dave List and John Carlson.

Counseling begins by establishing rapport and then by coaching the individual to conduct a needs assessment, collect data, establish time frames, identify goals, conduct a SWAT analysis, outline a business plan, and an implementation plan. All counseling services are free and confidential and last year 550 services were offered locally. They are always looking for new volunteers and the criteria to volunteer include the ability to listen, analyze and motivate.
