Karl is Deputy Director of District 5 which encompasses Coshocton, Fairfield, Guernsey, Knox, Licking, Muskingum and Perry Counties. He was appointed to this position in May, 2008, by Jolene Molitoris, Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation. As Deputy Director of District 5, he is responsible for the operating budget, the construction department with 55 ongoing projects and numerous maintenance projects. Additionally, Karl manages a workforce of 350 employees maintaining nearly 3,255 miles of State and Interstate highways. Mr. Newman started with District 5 nearly 20 years ago as a delivery worker, managing the inventory in the supply room for the entire district. He advanced through the department becoming the Building Construction Superintendent where he planned major construction projects, managed a \$3 million facilities operating budget and coordinated building projects with the State Architect's office.

Program:

John Bowers introduced speaker Kathy Nichols of the Ohio Attorney General's Office. She spoke about her efforts on behalf of the Cyber Safe Ohio Initiative, which takes here into many schools to educate students about the dangers of the Internet.

Besides showing us a picture of a small earth mover purchased by a 3-year-old, she gave a frank assessment of what kids are doing online. This includes those as young as 11 sending nude pictures, teens conducting virtual sex, bullying, cheating and visiting adult sites.

"Kids want to debate what's wrong with sexting and virtual sex," she said.

Online socializing can be a good thing, but kids are spending 7.5 hours online a day either at computers or on cell phones.

"Most kids have no rules for at home for online. Most parents have no idea where their kids go online."

So 55 percent have tried something risky. Ten percent have gone to physically meet someone they found online.

She said the solution is for parents to be involved and for all of us to make sure kids are taught cyber ethics.
