Program:

Today's speakers were introduced by **Rick Platt**. Andrea Stevenson and Karl Newman from the ODOT district office in Jacksontown discussed the future transportation plans for Ohio.

Andrea talked about the Go Ohio program which studies the transportation needs of the state and the solutions to meet those needs. The Go Ohio program encompasses all transportation including roads, rail, maritime, aviation and bike/pedestrian travel routes. The goal of the Go Ohio program is to make all transportation routes work in harmony. A good transportation system attracts business to the state.

Karl talked about local projects in the Licking County area including the Ohio 16/79 paving project, the Waterworks Road project, the North 21st Street project and the State Route 13/16 interchange project that was recently completed. He also said the Cherry Valley Road and State Route 16 project is in the design and environmental issues phase.
