## This week's program: District Gov. Calvin Gebhart

Mr. Gebhart has been President and CEO of The Citizens Bank since 1987. He has been employed by the Bank in other capacities since 1974. Mr. Gebhart is involved in many community activities throughout Pickaway County. In 1998, Mr. Gebhart received the Circleville Sertoma Service to Mankind Award. He is past president and past chairman of the Board of the Ohio Banker's Association and further serves as a Board Member of the Ashville Economic Development Committee, in addition to serving as a member of the Board of Trustees of Pickaway Health Services. Mr. Gebhart is past President of the Circleville Sunrise Rotary Club. In addition, he was appointed to the American Bankers Association Community Bank Council and was appointed to a three-year term to the American Bankers Association Membership Council. He was also appointed by former Ohio Gov. Taft to be a member of the Association of Ohio Commodores for the state of Ohio.
