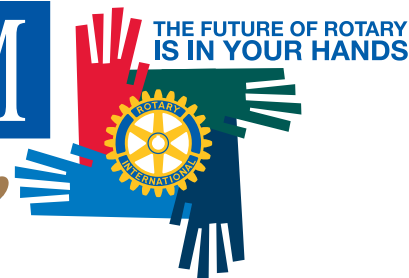

## **This week's program: Former OSU Quarter Back Art Schlichter**

Art has just released a new book called "Busted: The Rise and Fall of Art Schlichter. Here's a summary of the book from amazon.com.

Art Schlichter was a football God; was being the key word. After playing starting quarterback for coaches Woody Hayes and Earle Bruce at the Ohio State University, he was picked in the first round of the 1982 NFL draft by the Baltimore Colts. His star faded when his demons turned him into a gambling addict; swapping his life of football promise for one that would leave him outrunning the mob and the feds, stealing from his own mother and leaving his wife to care for two baby girls as he made 40 different prisons his home over ten years. An unimaginable fall from greatness, Schlichter tells the story of his trips to heaven and hell to sportswriter Jeff Snook.

Now retired from coaching, Conley is one of four football analysts who watch films, attend camps and monitor football games to evaluate more than 2,500 players in a single year. The analysts will select ESPN's top 150 players based on what they see. The analysts also write articles for each state specific to their top football athletes. His top pick this year is Matt Barclay, who is now the starting quarterback for USC.

Conley likes the attitude of the players and the coaches at OSU this year. He says "the guy" this year will be field goal kicker Aaron Pettrey. Conley also likes Terrelle Pryor for his decision-making skills and his timing. And, he says to keep an eye on Duron Carter.

Coach Conley says this should be a good year for the Big 10 conference. He says, however, that there are three things the conference is lacking: great running backs, not a lot of speed on the defensive line and pure passing quarterbacks. He says Florida has the best talent this year with the return of Heisman winner Tim Tebow.

Big games for OSU will be home against Illinois and at Penn State.
